The U.S. and the Muslim World: Engagements

This chapter is not only going to explain about the efforts of the U.S. towards Muslim World for resolving economic, political, environmental, and security concerns but also elucidating the response of Muslim World towards America. This research is very much important for the U.S. and the Muslim World because of the ongoing dichotomy between them.

Barack Obama speaks on January 20, 2009 in an inaugural address that "To Muslim World, we seek a new way forward, based on mutual interest and mutual respect." One must see this statement very scrupulously for enhancing the trust between two past rivals. It is a fact that any individual, group, family, tribe, village, city-states, states or empires were ever strong enough ideologically or economically it aggrandized itself. The aggrandizement was moral or immoral it was a separate question. This is how explained by Ahmad (2007) in an article, tilted as *War against Terrorism or War for Terrorism*, published in the second volume of the Journal of Political Studies:

Here we have an historical analysis to know about powerful nations' behaviour when they were stronger than the others were. What America is doing today for ruling over the world was done by Muslims in 640s A.D. Hazrat Umar's (RA) generals conquered Azerbaijan, Egypt, Iran, Iraq, Jordan, Khurasan, Kirman, Palestine, Seistan, and Syria, and included them into the Muslim empire.¹ If you ask any non Muslim about those conquests he may pronounce them a cruel act of history. Since non Muslims have their own perception.

"Empirical analysis discloses that in the third century Alexander the great conquered the world, in the fifth century Roman and Byzantine Empires came into existence, in the sixth century Muslims ruled over the world until the thirteenth century. Changaiz Khan and Mongols emerged in the thirteenth century and ruled for three centuries. In the sixteenth century Spanish rose in the world, the seventeenth century was of Dutch conquerors, the nineteenth century was of British Empire and in the twentieth century Zionism conquered the world through its multinational corporations. Consequently, the twenty first century can be considered a sharing between capitalism and Zionism.

These details give us a valid point that any nation when had power in the form of religion, economy, politics, or culture at any stage of history that did make conquests and made itself prosperous and dominant. Being a Muslim we can say that Muslim ventures were based on morality, while, the contemporary western ventures are based on selective morality. Since, the people of the west are not convinced with the notion of war against terrorism. Midterm elections of Senate held in America at the end of 2006 in which donkey defeated elephant is a categorical proof of peoples' disliking for war against terrorism."²

Therefore, it seems that today the U.S. masses are very vigilant and thinking in a prudential way. The U.S. nation is one of the best nations in the world. The writer himself visited the U.S. for three times in a year (2009-10) and found that there was nothing against human beings but ideology. Yes, it is true that the people in the U.S. believe that Muslims are terrorists, this perception increasing the differences between Muslims and the West especially the U.S. as it is leading the West.

First of all, the President of the U.S. needs to eliminate this perception through pragmatism and not by lip service. For the mutual respect and interest what the Report of the Leadership Group on U.S.-Muslim Engagement has suggested for the improvement of relations between the both parties under discussion are the same that has been in the foreign policy agenda of the U.S. towards the Muslim World. The U.S. needs more pragmatism in its approach and Muslims need more tolerance towards other communities of the world. Here are the efforts that Muslims render towards normalization of relations towards the West and the U.S.:

Muslim Efforts for Peace

The Arab-Israel war 1947-1970 was a total aggression towards Muslims and the west and the U.S. had been supporting to the Israel cause under different connotations. The Camp David Accord is the pertinent example in this pretext that a Muslim country Egypt made a peace accord with Israel in the Middle East. Different phases of history tell us a different story about the selective attitude of the U.S. and the West against Muslims of the world. In Palestine, Hamas government was ousted by the U.S. and Israel coalitional struggle in 2007. "Israel concluded peace treaties with Egypt in 1979 and Jordan in 1994, but not with Syria and Lebanon."³

Israel unilaterally withdrew from southern Lebanon in 2000. Iran categorically, has explained that its nuclear programme is for peaceful purposes while the Israel, U.S., and the West are considering it against their national interests. The country like Canada is being considered pro Israel country more than the U.S. "... [U]nder Prime Minister Stephen Harper's Conservative government, Canada has become (at least diplomatically) the most pro-Israel country in the world."⁴ these arguments show that the selective attitude of the Europe, U.S., and the West are sowing the seeds of discontent and discrimination among the peoples of the world. We have to be careful for sustaining peace; it is sine qua non that the big powers must be very much efficient in their dealing with the aggrieved party. The Muslims of the world are the aggrieved party after 9/11 incident. How Muslims of the World are disgraced at the international air ports, job places, films, newspapers and at all other communication sources, are absolutely discriminatory and not favouring the peace process. On the other hand Muslims are consistently struggling for peace as it is an integral part of the Islamic civilization. It does not mean that they cannot fight against any terrorist act. It is not like that. This is how Muslims usually behave. They act when somebody hurt them first. Muslims like to forgive but consistent irritation from the enemy may force Muslims to wage war against the enemy. They are not scare of dying. Patience, tolerance, respect for others are pristine canons of Islam. The West may take advantage of the leniency of the Muslim civilization for the time being in the longer run it would be catastrophic for the whole world.

During the Cartoon Controversy in 2005, was another effort of the West to irritate Muslims but the Muslims did not do anything that hurt other religions. This is how Muslims are sustaining peace in the world. Dr. Zakir Naik entry banned in the U.K. in 2010 for considering his speeches against peace. It is awfully shameful for the U.K. government that a person who never talking of differences among religions but similarities, denied to enter in the U.K. These are the tactics of the West for disturbing the peace process in the world.

The U.S. Efforts for Peace

The U.S. president assumed power in 2008 and spoke first to a Muslim news agency Aljazeera and visited Egypt for addressing Muslims of the world. His recent statement regarding building up a masjid at ground zero, and considering it as a 'right' of Muslims living in New York⁵ can be considered a positive gesture in lieu of bridging the gap between humanity and ideology. The U.S. assumes itself a secular state and emphasizes on respecting others' religions should set examples for practicing tolerance towards others' religion. All these examples are very much pertinent in making our belief stronger that the U.S. is also interested in getting closer to the Muslim community in the world. The lacuna lies only in words and practices.

Therefore, I hope that this process of Islamization will go on in America that can bring them home to think wisely rather wildly. May be one can believe that it is a height of optimism or living in fool's paradise. What I believe that it is better to live in fool's paradise than to live in a world where "war of all against all"⁷ is going on, recalling Thomas Hobbes' Leviathan, in which he wrote about three hundred years back that "quest for power after power that ceaseth only in death."⁸

The U.S. 44th president Barak Obama's efforts to bring Muslims of the world close to other communities of the world is appreciable but the question is how can he stop the incidents of Freedom Flotilla where innocent Turks were killed for humanitarian reasons. Why the U.S. is till supporting the Israel? The answer is very simple that the U.S. economy is under the control of the Israeli business tycoons. The recent peace talks between Israel Prime Minister Netanyahu and Palestinian president Mahmood Abbas may be considered as a breakthrough for Obama administration in September 2010.

Conclusion

It's the reality that after the end of cold war the U.S became the sole super power of the world. History shows that there has never been a powerful country as the U.S was. New World Order emerged in which no other country was capable to compete or to challenge the U.S power in economic as well as in military fields. Since the mid of twentieth century, the U.S has assumed the hegemonic power role and capitalist ideology ruled the world against communist ideology. Then the U.S started a policy to police the world and had intervened into the internal affairs of many countries in order to protect them against the evils of communism. The U.S allegations of lack of democratic values in Muslim world, lack of basic human rights, committing violence and terrorism and anti –Israel views by Muslims must be removed by finding their proper solution. In the same way some allegations are also pointed out by

Muslims like U.S hegemony creating problems for Muslims, Muslims are victims of U.S aggression, double standards with respect to democracy and human rights, anti Muslim views and wrong portrayal of Muslims by U.S media must be resolved.

The U.S must play the role of big brother not big boss, in order to resolve the grievances of Muslims world. In return Muslims should co-operate with U.S and find the way out from violence, aggression and wars for the safety of humanity.

Therefore, the U.S. has to decide to save itself from global disgrace or to support the injustice being done against Muslims in the Middle East by Israelis. The U.S. is a big power today; it has to play a vital role in resolving the grievances of the Muslim world. The increased role of Israel aggression in the Middle East may hamper the peace process in the whole world. It is high time and call of the day to stop Jewish and Christian extremism against innocent Muslims to save the world from the Third World War that is imminent ion the prevailing circumstances. This research is not against Jews but an admonishing for Americans to preserve their identity as it is in question. Samuel P. Huntington has written Who Are We? The Challenges to America's National Identity, pertains to the identity crises in America. He says, "America was created as a Protestant society just as and for some of the same reasons Pakistan and Israel were created as Muslim and Jewish societies in the twentieth century." Traditionally the west is considered more democratic than the rest part of the world. America and the U.K. are comprised of successful democratic systems but their systems are no more credible as both are supporting the terrorists at the instance of Jewish lobby. It is pity to believe that two big powers of the world used to be known as civilized are under severe threat of discontent and disorder at home owing to wagging their tails for winning Jewish favour.

It is very hard to believe that "...Western civilization is composed of communities held together by a political process, and by the rights and duties of citizen as defined that process...." If it is really so why it (the West) blindly supporting the terrorists, yes it is also supporting terrorists if one is creating such situation that do favour the terrorist activities. As we all know that terrorist acts hurt the Muslims in the world over the most rather than any other community of the world. Scruton says that "...the form of multinational corporations, international courts, or transnational legislatures....pose a new kind of threat to the only form of sovereignty that has brought lasting (albeit local) peace to our planet."
